

Mental Health Awareness - Be Prepared

The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) <u>launched</u> a new three-digit <u>Suicide & Crisis Lifeline</u>, 988. This new three-digit number is replacing the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline (800-273-8255), which remains available. The goal behind creating the new three-digit code is to make accessing mental health services easier to remember during a behavioral health emergency, similar to how 911 has become synonymous with contacting the police for other emergencies.

The 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline offers 24/7 call, text and chat access to compassionate, accessible care and support for anyone experiencing mental health related distress. That includes thoughts of suicide, substance use crisis or any other mental health or emotional distress. The Lifeline is a national network of more than 200 crisis centers staffed with trained crisis counselors that helps thousands of people overcome crisis situations every day. People can also use 988 if they are worried about someone else who may need crisis support. The Lifeline provides live crisis center phone services in English and Spanish

What can people expect when they reach out to 988? Call 988:

After a greeting message, callers will be routed to the local Lifeline network crisis center based on their area code.

<u>Veterans</u> can press "1" after dialing 988 to connect directly to the Veterans Crisis Lifeline, which serves our nation's veterans, service members (including National Guard and Reserve members) and those who support them.

Text 988:

When someone texts 988, a trained crisis counselor at a group of Lifeline crisis centers will respond.

Chat:

Available through the Lifeline's website @ (988lifeline.org) Chat bar in top right corner.

Whether it's via the phone, text, or chat, once connected, a trained crisis counselor listens, works to understand the problem, then provides support and shares resources that may be helpful.
